Cricket

1st team match report (Mr Kyle Nipper – Director of Cricket & 1st team coach)

The Maritzburg College 1st XI took on Glenwood on Saturday. Glenwood won the toss and chose to field. College got off to a slow start on what was a tricky wicket to bat on. Two quick wickets in the 8th over left College in a bit of trouble at 16/2. A small recovery from opener Elam and captain, van der Walt got College to 38/3. Vice captain, Dean Dyer then joined his captain and the pair put on 72 before both fell in the 40's. A few contributions from the middle to lower order managed to get College to a decent and defendable 185/9. Glenwood's paceman Lifa Ntanzi was the pick of the bowlers with 5/32 from his 10 overs.

The Maritzburg College bowlers and fielders came out firing after lunch and opening bowlers, Sanele Mbatha and Andile Simelane, were in devastating form having the Glenwood batters reeling at 32/5 after 10 overs. Mbatha picking up three wickets (3/26) and Simelane the other two (2/16). The change bowlers kept the pressure on the Glenwood batsmen and two wickets a piece for spinners Chad Fortmann and Elam and one for seamer, Michael King, saw the visitors being bowled out for 71. Maritzburg College were clinical in their performance which gave them a resounding win by 114 runs.
