College had the ascendancy early on in the game and managed to draw first blood with a very well timed run from Siya Ningiza. This was a very special moment indeed as it was also his birthday on Saturday. Henry Trodd managed to convert the try from the left-hand corner of the field with an incredible place kick.

College played most of the rugby in the 1<sup>st</sup> half and did their best to pin Glenwood back in their half. Unfortunately the lineout wasn't functioning on the day and therefore College had to feed off the opposition's mistakes to get possession. Late in the 1<sup>st</sup> half Glenwood scored a try through their outside centre Van Wyk who managed to shrug off a tackle from the College midfield to score and open Glenwood's account. Soon after they scored another try and went into half time at 12 – 7 up.

In the second half, Maritzburg College had many opportunities to convert pressure into points but unfortunately their accuracy was lacking. College had bouts of poor discipline and were often penalised early in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half for being off-side. Glenwood's Joe Jonas managed to convert one of these penalties to make the score 15-7 in Glenwood's favour. With two minutes to spare College managed to move the ball wide with some slick handling and Siya Ningiza set off on another barnstorming run, getting the offload away to Khwezi Hadebe who seemingly crashed over in the corner for another five-pointer. Unfortunately the try was disallowed as the pass was deemed to be forward. The final score was 15-07 to Glenwood.

### Hockey

College's hockey teams dominated against Glenwood this weekend with the summary of results showing we played 10 matches, winning 8, drawing 2, and losing none.

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Team Match Report – Dylan Coombes – Director of Hockey & 1<sup>st</sup> team coach)**

A rainy and cool day in Durban welcomed the hockey fraternity to 3 Schools Astro turf for the opening fixture of the 2<sup>nd</sup> term where College faced Glenwood. The much anticipated 1<sup>st</sup> XI match showed to be a game of two halves.

In the first half it was all College with the Maritzburg team really playing some good structured hockey and in so doing created most of the play. College were rewarded with 2 goals in the first half through D Bruyns and L Jansen van Vuuren respectively. Bruyns scored in the 10th minute when brilliant build up play and multiple phases saw him receive the ball outside the circle with lots of work still to do. Bruyns turned his defender before some good aerial skills found him in the circle where he wasted no time in firing into the Glenwood backboard to open the scoring on the day. Just seconds before the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter drew to a close, more really good possession and control saw College stretching Glenwood on the pitch. L. Jansen van Vuuren burst forward at speed where a perfectly timed pass found him ahead of his defender on the far post where a simple tap in put College 2-0 up and in a commanding position. Glenwood had other ideas and took the early pressure in their stride when they won themselves a penalty corner in the latter stages of the first half. A superb flick into the bottom left corner brought one back as that half drew to a close at 2-1 to College.

The second half started and College could not keep up their quality of the first half and produced none of the clinical sharp play they did in the first half. First half chances gone begging would come back to haunt College as the longer the second half played out, the closer Glenwood got to equalizing. Ten minutes from the end of the game and Glenwood equalized when an uncharacteristic stray pass handed Glenwood possession on the right hand side. A quickly taken free hit saw Glenwood enter the circle and muscle their way into a position to score when a goal mouth scramble saw the ball cross the line for the equalizer. With 2-2 being the final score, College never managed to capitalize on large periods of dominant play.
