### Cricket

This weekend our cricketers played 20 matches, with 11 wins and 7 losses and 2 draws.

#### 1st team Report (Mr Robbie Coutts – 1<sup>st</sup> XI Coach)

The College First XI squared off against Hilton College this weekend in a 110 over declaration game. The team played positive cricket and drew the match against the hosts. In near perfect batting conditions Hilton won the toss and had no hesitation in electing to bat first on the Hart Davis Oval.

The start to the bowling innings was frustrated by a drop catch by the visiting team, College would go onto rue this early missed opportunity to dismiss Hilton opening batsman Slade Van Staden off the bowling of Andile Simelane. Van Staden went on to top score with 110 runs.

Despite the miss the Colleges bowlers stuck to their plans in conditions made for batting. The introduction of leg spinner Mark Laithwaite, and the tea interval, brought about a renewed energy for the College fielders. Laithwaite bowled a notable spell of 22 overs on the trot, restricting the Hilton batsmen to a meagre 79 runs off his spell. Hilton declared at the lunch break, on 295 for 3 in 58 overs.

The College run chase started well with Daniel Bruyns and Stefan Delpport opening the batting positively against the Hilton seam bowlers. The introduction of Hilton captain and leg spinner Colby Dyer resulted in immediate success for Hilton. Dyer dismissed both College openers within 3 overs. A solid 48 run partnership followed between vice-captain Ross Klusener and Tyler Guise Brown. Guise Brown was dismissed LBW for a well played 31. The fall of this wicket brought together, team leadership, Klusener and Kent Goedeke. The pair put on a faultless 127 partnership, at a great rate, giving the opposition no chances to dismiss them. The partnership was broken in the 47<sup>th</sup> over when Goedeke was out for a well played 77. Klusener was unbeaten on 62 at the close of play. College ended on a respectable 225 for 4 in 52 overs to draw the match.

### **Basketball**

It was a busy week for basketball at College with teams playing against Weston, Maritzburg Christian School and Hilton in the main. A total of 23 matches were played in the week with College winning 16 of these games.

#### **1<sup>st</sup> team report (Jenny Orchard)**

There was a great deal pre-match banter on social media related to the first team match as both sides were fully aware of the importance of a victory. Hilton made their intentions clear from the get-go, winning the jump-ball and putting points on the board within the first few seconds of the game. Both teams in the first quarter played with fire and intensity but it was Hilton who were able to penetrate the College defence effectively. This resulted in College being in foul trouble within the first 5 minutes of the game and was the undoing of the team. The first quarter concluded with College being 4 points ahead but the second quarter belonged to Hilton with the hosts outscoring College by 5 points and maintaining a slender lead of a single point (34 – 33) at the half time break. At the start of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter Hilton cemented their lead but through a determined effort by the College players and greater accuracy at the hoop College reduced the lead enjoyed by the home team. In the final quarter many free throws were awarded to both teams and it was the simple fact that Hilton had a greater conversion rate that won them the game. The final whistle sounded and much to the delight of the home crowd and the team Hilton was assured of a 79 – 73 victory. Once again Nhlakanipho Ngcobo topped scored for College adding 21 points to his tally.
