WHAT IS THE 100MILLIONFORCOLLEGE CAMPAIGN?

The 100MillionforCollege Campaign is a historic five-year campaign to create a R100million endowment fund for the school.

Endowment funds are critical sources of permanent, long-term funding for successful educational institutions the world over. They enable them to make commitments far into the future, knowing that resources to meet those commitments will continue to be available. A strong endowment provides financial depth and permits confident planning.

The capital raised will be preserved intact, with the income generated used to meet pressing financial needs such as bursaries and to improve the school's extensive infrastructure. As Maritzburg College heads towards the end of the second century of its existence, it is of the utmost importance that the school is placed on more sound financial footing.

The 100MillionforCollege Campaign will be the focal point for the school's fundraising activities over the coming years.

WHY THE 100MILLIONFORCOLLEGE CAMPAIGN?

Maritzburg College is a thriving, diverse, and truly exceptional institution. For over a century-and-a-half, our venerable institution has provided quality education to thousands of boys, leaving an indelible influence on the life of the province and broader South African society in the process. Old Collegians have left their mark in all spheres of life; be it business, politics, sport or the arts.

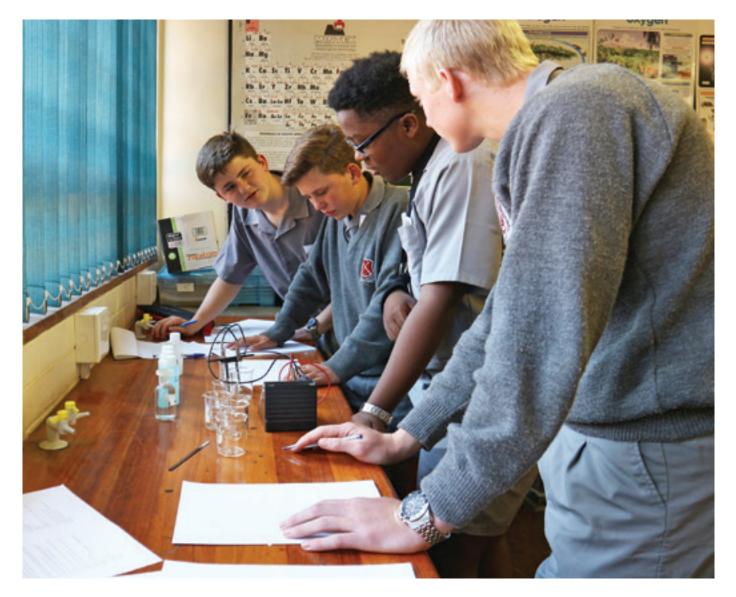
Until 1992 the College experience was the preserve of the country's white minority. Opening to all races has strengthened the school immeasurably. It is now truly connected to South African society – both its harsh realities and its vast potential.

This is reflected in its education, which is more relevant to a modern, changing world. Maritzburg College boys are now better placed to develop an outward-looking "South African mindset" and a level of multi-cultural competence that has become increasingly important in the outside world.



In many ways, Maritzburg College is in a better place than it has ever been. The school continues to excel at offering a high-quality holistic education. It has made significant strides academically over the past decade; it is now the top performing public boys' school in the country outside of the Western Cape.

The school offers a tremendously diverse range of sports; participation rates are as high as ever; and College boys continue to excel on the many sporting fields that they take to. The school provides a rich cultural experience too; a thriving Music Department; the opportunity for boys to select Visual Arts and Dramatic Arts as formal subjects; and many College boys actively engage in a vibrant extra-curricular creative programme.



Maintaining this outstanding record of achievement, however, requires a new approach. College is facing significant financial challenges. While it does receive an annual government subsidy, this covers only a fraction of the school's operating budget. To maintain the school's high standards, it has become increasingly dependent on fees charged to parents.

The result has been steep inflation in the cost of a College education, which threatens to put the life-changing opportunity to attend the school out of reach for many. One of the school's key strengths over the years has been its ability to bring in boys from varying socio-economic backgrounds. This is now at risk.

Another critical issue is the fact that the school does not have sufficient funds for capital projects and the tight operating budget leaves little room for maintaining and improving the school's extensive infrastructure. The quality of the school's facilities is integral to College's overall offering; without a reliable long-term funding source, it will increasingly come under threat. There are **several distinctive features** of the campaign that will help drive its success:

• MATCHING:

Fifty "Legacy Donors" will each pledge R1m to the campaign. This pledge will be made on a matching basis - for every Rand raised by the campaign, the Legacy Donors collectively will contribute a Rand.

- **FLEXIBILITY:** Donations can be made in different ways:
 - 1) Single Lump Sum
 - 2) Annual Payment
 - 3) Monthly Debit Order
- **ALLOCATION:** Donors will have the option to allocate their funds to different categories:
 - 1) Scholarships & Bursaries
 - 2) Capital Projects
 - 3) No Preference

RECOGNITION:

Significant donors will be publicly recognised as follows:

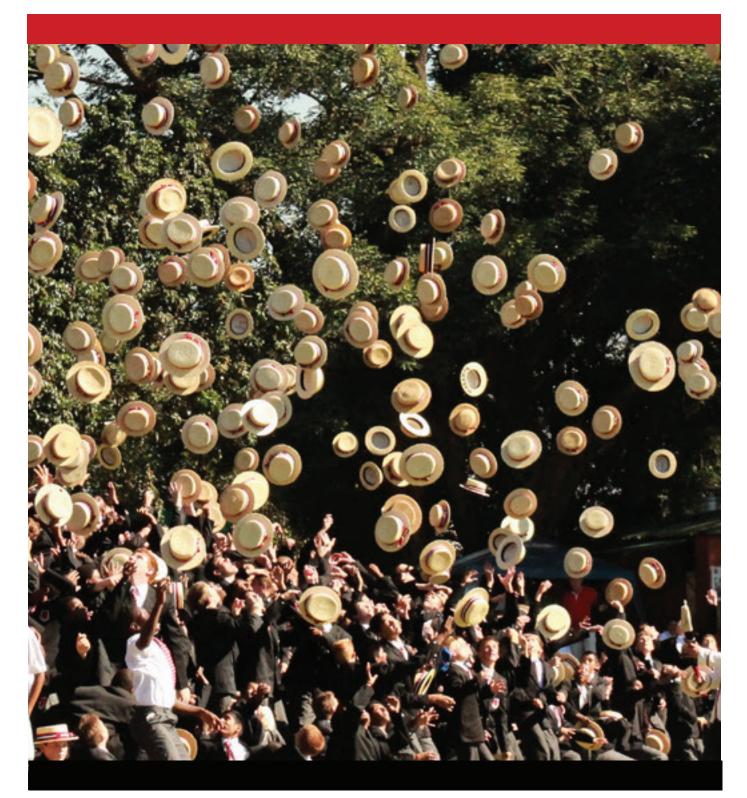
- R 10,000: Bronze Donor
- **R 25,000:** Silver Donor
- **R 50,000:** Gold Donor
- **R 100,000:** Emerald Donor
- **R 150,000:** Diamond Donor
- **R 250,000:** Platinum Donor
- **R 500,000:** Prestige Donor
- **R 1,000,000:** Legacy Donor



Prestige and Legacy Donors who allocate their donations to scholarships and bursaries will have the naming rights to these. They can choose to connect with their beneficiary, whose development at College they can track.

• GLOBAL REACH:

The campaign will be a global one, drawing in Old Collegians from around the world. It presents a unique opportunity for the school to reconnect with its widely dispersed alumni base.



HOW WILL THE FUNDS BE MANAGED?

The funds will be raised via the Maritzburg College Foundation and invested through the **Maritzburg College and Old Boys' Memorial Trust.**

An Investment Policy Statement will be developed, including a fund investment strategy and the percentage of income that can be drawn each year. The process outlining how funding requests to the Trust will be made will be independently monitored. Legacy Donor representatives will be added as Trustees and will have specific approval rights in this regard.

TAX DEDUCTABILITY OF DONATIONS

Any prospective donation tax benefit accruing to the donor will be regulated by the country in which the donation is made.

The Maritzburg College Foundation is a registered Public Benefit Organisation (PBO) with the South African Revenue Service (SARS) and enjoys S18A status which permits the issuing of donation tax certificates to South African tax-payers.

The Maritzburg College Foundation is also registered in the US (through Charities Aid Foundation of America) and the UK (through UK Fund for Charities) which enables tax-payers in these countries to make tax deductible donations to the Maritzburg College Foundation.
