#### **GROUP ACCIDENT SCHEME FOR SCHOLARS:**

Parents are urged to thoughtfully consider taking advantage of the Group Personal Accident Insurance (GPA) offered through the school. The insurance will serve as accident cover for learners without medical aid as well as additional accident cover for those who already have medical aid.

In accordance with our safety protocols, the School Executive has made the decision that NO boy who is scheduled to participate in any sport festival and/or tournament may attend without sufficient medical insurance. Such insurance could either be in the form of the school insurance (GPA), or own private medical aid/insurance which MUST cover Accident & Emergency procedures at a hospital.

The due date for the insurance payment and confirmation of agreement is on or before 31 January 2024. You will be sent the agreement and will be able to pay via the School's Web Payment Portal. You will need to add the relevant Insurance type into your basket and process payment before we will be able to register your son onto the insurance policy.

**IMPORTANT**: please note that your son will only be covered once we are in receipt of:

- 1) The returned signed agreement, emailed to Zamo Mhlongo at insuranceadmin@mcollege.co.za and
- 2) Proof of Payment, via the Payment Portal.

#### **TUITION AND BOARDING FEES**

We thank you most sincerely for your commitment in paying fees and also for the sacrifices we know many of you have made in order to pay them.

I confirm that the fees for 2024 are as follows:

### Form 2 (2024)

#### 1. School Fee R72 800

Discount options are being offered to all parents for 2024 school fees, parents whose payments reflect in the Maritzburg College's bank account in full as per the dates below are entitled to an early settlement discount as follows:

4% for payment by 31 December 2023

The tuition fees may be paid in ten or eleven monthly instalments; parents were provided with a Tuition and or Boarding Fee Payment Options - 2024 letter and survey, if any changes are required, please inform the Finance Office urgently. Payments will run from January to October or November 2024. The election to pay over ten or eleven months must be made before 30 November 2023, should you not make an election, the full fees are due and payable by no later than 31 January 2024.

## 2. **Boarding Fee R105 500**

Kindly note the termly option of R26 375 is payable in advance prior to the start of the respective term, or monthly (including interest) should you make this election. Should payment not be received for the term or should you fall into arrears, your son will be excluded in the first week of the new term or at a free weekend.

Discount options are being offered to all parents for 2024 Boarding fees, parents whose payments reflect in the Maritzburg College's bank account in full as per the dates below are entitled to an early settlement discount as follows:

4% for payment by 31 December 2023

The boarding fees may be paid in ten or eleven monthly instalments, including interest; parents will be required to complete the survey sent in the Tuition and or Boarding Fee Payment Options – 2024 letter. Payments will run from January to October or November 2024. The election to pay over ten or eleven months must be made before 30 November 2023, should you not make an election the full fees are due and payable by no later than 31 January 2024. The terms and conditions of the Boarding Establishment will be adhered to, and no waiver of interest will be considered for monthly payment terms.

### Form 3-6 (2024)

#### School Fee R68 100

Discount options are being offered to all parents for 2024 school fees, parents whose payments reflect in the Maritzburg College's bank account in full as per the dates below are entitled to an early settlement discount as follows:

4% for payment by 31 December 2023

### 4. Boarding Fee R100 600

Kindly note the termly option of R25 150 is payable in advance prior to the start of the respective term or monthly (including interest) should you make this election. Should payment not be received for the term or should you fall into arrears, your son will be excluded in the first week of the new term or at a free weekend.

Discount options are being offered to all parents for 2024 Boarding fees, parents whose payments reflect in the Maritzburg College's bank account in full as per the dates below are entitled to an early settlement discount as follows:

4% for payment by 31 December 2023

The boarding fees may be paid in ten or eleven monthly instalments, including interest; parents will be required to complete the survey sent in the Tuition and or Boarding Fee Payment Options – 2024 letter. Payments will run from January to October or November 2024. The election to pay over ten or eleven months must be made before 30 November 2023, should you not make an election the full fees are due and payable by no later than 31 January 2024. The terms and conditions of the Boarding Establishment will be adhered to, and no waiver of interest will be considered for monthly payment terms.

#### Please note:

Both fees will be invoiced separately in full to your son's 'T' and 'B' account during 2024 in accordance with your election of your payment terms.

# **Tuition Fee Exemption**

Legislation entitles parents to apply for exemptions of school fees, subject to set criteria. While people who are eligible are clearly entitled to apply, we would at the same time ask our community as far as is possible to restrict such applications to cases of absolute necessity. This will hopefully ensure that the budgeted allocation of assistance is adequate and therefore that there will be no further imposition on our parent community. It will be requested of all parents applying for fee remissions to make voluntary contribution towards their son's fees. All parents who apply for a remission of fees will be asked to attend a meeting with a designated member of Management. Parents are reminded that no subsidy is received from the State and any assistance given is borne by the other fee-paying parents. The remission or exemption of fees applies only to dayboys. Boarders may not apply for exemption for either day or boarding fees. ### **RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED AT THE BUDGET MEETING HELD ON 27 OCTOBER 2023 FOR 2024 FEES**

In terms of Section 38(1), Section 39(1) and Section 39(2) of the South African Schools Act 84 of 1996, it is resolved by the majority of the parents in attendance that:

# 1. BUDGET - 2024

1.1. The budget as presented, which reflects the estimated cumulative effect of the established trends of non-payment of school fees at Maritzburg College and the total, partial or conditional exemptions granted to parents at Maritzburg College, is approved and accepted.

#### 2. NOTICE OF BUDGET MEETING

- 2.1. Notice of the budget meeting was given to parents of the School on 26 September 2023 and that a period of at least 30 days has lapsed since notice was given as is required by Section 38(2) of SASA.
- 2.2. The notice of the budget meeting informed the parents of the School that the budget would be available for inspection at least 14 days prior to the budget meeting as is required by Section 38(3) of SASA.
- 2.3. The budget was available for inspection at least 14 days prior to the budget meeting.

#### 3. SCHOOL FEES - 2024

- 3.1. School fees may be determined and charged at Maritzburg College.
- 3.2. School fees at Maritzburg College for 2024 for 2<sup>nd</sup> Form (Grade 8) will be R72 800, which includes a differential rate of R 4 700 per learner per annum and excludes the deposit already paid. The school fees for 2024 for 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Form (Grade 9 -12) will be R 68 100 per learner per annum.
- 3.3. The school fees do not include personal accident insurance for individual learners. This is available as an optional extra, at a cost to be debited to parents, and at the specific request of parents, on whom the onus rests to exercise this option.
- 3.4. School fees at Maritzburg College will be payable in advance in full on or before 31st January 2024.
- 3.5. The Governing Body of Maritzburg College may accept payment of school fees in ten or eleven monthly instalments starting January and thereafter payable before the end of each subsequent month, to be paid in full by the end of October or November if so selected, provided that the Terms & Conditions (part of the Application Form) have been properly completed, signed.
- 3.6. Should the parents' personal details or circumstances change, they are required to notify the school in writing of such change.
- 3.7. Section 41 of the South African Schools Act process via the school collection attorneys will apply to all overdue accounts which have not been honoured, as per either of the prescribed pre-selected two options (see Points 3.4 & 3.5 above).
- 3.8. The 2024 Tuition deposit of R2 200 (excluding the book deposit of R1 500) will be credited to the last month of the last year of tuition fees i.e. 6<sup>th</sup> Form, or the year of withdrawal from Maritzburg College. Fee exemption parents will receive their deposit only after any Sundries account amounts that may be owing are deducted. The credit will be applied to any handed-over accounts there may be at the end of the learner's career; if due, the balance will be refunded. Refunds must be formally requested in writing by parents, together with their banking details. Refund of a deposit requires a term's notice period prior to refund in conjunction with a formal withdrawal notice at Admissions. Deposits are forfeited if these withdrawal procedures are not followed. Learners not returning at the beginning of any given year or term who do not adhere to the notice period will forfeit their deposit.
- 3.9. The book deposit of R1 500 will be retained in a separate account to cover any text or library books not returned annually by a pupil. Should these funds become depleted additional funds will be required.
- 3.10. Payment of Tuition fees by debit order will be compulsory for all parents (unless otherwise negotiated prior to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024). Debit orders, currently in place for 2023, will be carried forward by the Finance Department into 2024 and the amount of the debit order will be adjusted according to the fees as approved at the AGM. Please consider the termly option dates for your financial planning and allow five working days for your debit order clearance. In 2024, termly payment dates will be: 17<sup>th</sup> January, 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 9<sup>th</sup> July and 1<sup>st</sup> October.
- 3.11. Payment of Boarding fees by debit order will be compulsory for all forms (unless otherwise negotiated prior to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024). Debit orders, currently in place for 2023, will be carried forward by the Finance Department into 2024 and the amount of the debit order will be adjusted according to the fees as approved at the AGM. Please consider the termly option dates for your financial planning and allow five working days for your debit order clearance. In 2024, termly payment dates will be: 17<sup>th</sup> January, 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 9<sup>th</sup> July and 1<sup>st</sup> October.
- 3.12. A debit order facility for Sundries accounts is available as an option and is not compulsory. Debit order forms can be obtained from the Finance Department.
- 3.13. Payments received from Boarder parents will be allocated first to their sons' Tuition fees, if these are in arrears, and thereafter, to Boarding fees.
- 3.14. A "debtors fee" of R2 000 will be charged for anyone electing to not comply with the debit order system, and who has not paid in full by 31 January 2024;
- 3.15. A fee of R300 will be charged for any returned debit order;
- 3.16. Payments exceeding the agreed payment period attract interest at 5% above FNB Prime interest rate for all balances remaining after 30 November 2024;
- 3.17. School & Boarding fee payments made with cash, credit or debit cards attract a charge equal to the related bank charges: 1.725% for cash; 2.185% for credit cards; & 1.15% for debit cards. Any early settlement discount is reduced in accordance with the above cash deposit, credit card and debit card charges;
- 3.18. Early settlement discounts are not applicable to parents who have received financial assistance from, or a partial scholarship/bursary from, Maritzburg College.
- 3.19. A daily boarding rate for day boys who need to stay over for short periods of time, of R525 per night;

- 3.20. A full term's notice, in writing, or one (1) term's fee in lieu of notice, is required before the withdrawal of a pupil either from the School or the Boarding Establishment.
- 3.21. For 6<sup>th</sup> Form (Grade 12), once the year has commenced (whether a Day Scholar or Boarder) notice of withdrawal will not result in any reduction in the annual fee payable.
- 3.22. That no learner will be admitted to the Boarding Establishment in the event of Boarding and/or Tuition fees and/or Sundries being outstanding or unpaid for the previous month, term or year.

### 4. APPLICATIONS FOR EXEMPTION FROM OR REDUCTION IN SCHOOL (TUITION) FEES ONLY

- 4.1. The following procedure shall apply for exemption from and/or reduction in school fees:
  - 4.1.1. That an appointment be made with the Debtors Manager to collect application forms.
  - 4.1.2. That all applications for exemption from or reduction in school fees must be submitted to the Debtors Manager, alternatively the Accountant, of Maritzburg College on the prescribed form on or before 28 February 2024 or within 60 days of change of circumstances.
  - 4.1.3. Interviews may be conducted to verify information given by parents in respect of any aspect of the application for exemption or reduction in school fees and prescribed affidavit before any exemption is granted.
  - 4.1.4. That parents may appeal to the Head of Department at the KZNED against the decision of the Governing Body of Maritzburg College regarding exemption from or reduction in school fees, within 30 days of having received written notification from the school.
- 4.2. Single parents/ custodian parents may apply for exemption from or reduction in school fees, without the consent of the other biological parent/non-custodian parent, subject to the following conditions:
  - 4.2.1. That the single parent/ custodian so applying, must complete and sign the prescribed affidavit setting out the grounds why the application is made without the consent of the other biological parent/non-custodial parent.
  - 4.2.2. The full contact details of the other biological parent/non-custodial parent must be provided in the prescribed affidavit and a copy of the child/ children's unabridged birth certificate(s) must be submitted with the prescribed affidavit.
  - 4.2.3. That the duly completed and signed prescribed affidavit must be submitted to the Debtors Manager before an application for exemption from or reduction in school fees may be submitted.
  - 4.2.4. That a single parent/ custodian parent may not apply for exemption from or reduction in school fees until the prescribed affidavit has been submitted to the School.
  - 4.2.5. That both the prescribed affidavit and applications for exemption from or reduction in school fees must be submitted to the Debtors Manager of the School on or before 28 February 2024, or within 60 days of change of circumstances.
- 4.3. The Governing Body must consider the combined gross income of the parents as defined in the 'Regulations for Exemption of Parents from Payment of School Fees', Government Gazette R1052 published on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2006, when processing all applications for exemption from or reduction in school fees.
- 4.4. The Governing Body may delegate the handling of all applications for exemption from and reduction in school fees to the Accountant alternatively the Debtors Manager.
- 4.5. Should no application for exemption from and/or reduction in school fees on the prescribed form be received by latest 28 February 2024, or within 60 days of change of circumstances, parents shall be 'ipso facto' barred from later applying for an exemption from or reduction in school fees.
- 4.6. The remission or exemption of fees applies only to dayboys. Boarders may not apply for exemption for either tuition or boarding fees.

### 5. SECTION 38A PAYMENTS

- 5.1. The Governing Body of the School may make an application in terms of Sections 38A(1) and 38A(2) of SASA to the Head of Department of the Department of Education for additional payments to State paid employees employed at the School.
- 5.2. The said application must be made in writing and comply with Section 38A(3) of SASA.
- 5.3. The payments contemplated in this Section of SASA have been reflected in the school budget.
- 5.4. The Governing Body of the School may appeal to the Member of the Executive Council against—
  - 5.4.1. the refusal by the Head of Department of the Department of Education of the application; or
  - 5.4.2. the failure of the Head of Department of the Department of Education to provide a decision on an application within three months after the lodging of the application in the office of the Head of Department of the Department of Education.

#### 6. IMPLEMENTATION OF RESOLUTION

6.1. These resolutions, as adopted and passed by the majority of parents in attendance, must be implemented by the Governing Body of the School.
