THE BIG BASH

Game conditions

- All matches to start at advertised times.
- All captains will do the toss at the start.
- Matches will be played simultaneously
- Please ensure that you hand your team sheets to the scorers before play starts.

Bowling conditions

- Ten overs per team (5 in a row from either end)
- A <u>minimum</u> of 6 bowlers must be used for all matches. Maximum of 2 overs per bowler
- Wides will be a 2-run penalty and no extra ball bowled
- No-balls will be a 2-run penalty and no extra ball bowled
- If 3 wides or no-balls are bowled consecutively, a further 2 run penalty will be awarded to the batting team. (W 2, W 2, W 2 + 2)
- No longer than 5 m run up, run-up lines will be painted on the field.

Batting conditions

• Batsmen to retire on 25, he may come back once another 4 wickets have fallen.

- 4 fielders in the ring at all times. Supper served to players during the match
