Tie Ceremony – A New Journey!



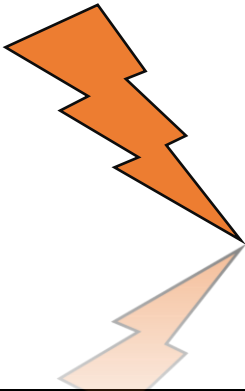
Exciting times lay ahead for the new intake of Maritzburg College boys 2025 – seen here donning their ties for the first time.
