* Boarders Return

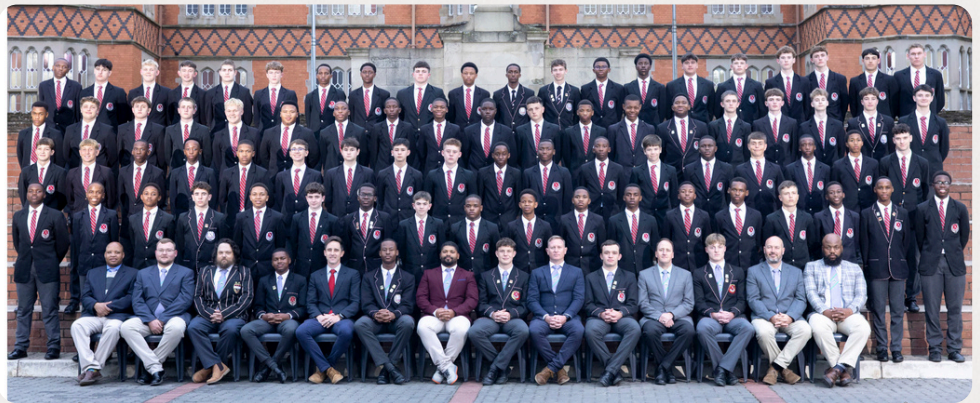
13 Jan 2026
