BASKETBALL AT MARITZBURG COLLEGE

Maritzburg College's basketball programme has established itself as one of the school's most dynamic sporting codes, characterised by major expansion seen in recent years.

After reaching a milestone of 23 teams and 350 players in 2022, while maintaining an 80% win rate, the programme has continued its upward trajectory. Today, College fields a total of 33 basketball teams, representing what is arguably the biggest basketball programme in the country.

The programme's competitive heritage remains a cornerstone of its identity. In 2024, the 1st team achieved a historic milestone by completing an undefeated KZN inter-school season, a feat last accomplished by the renowned 1991 side.

This consistent performance was recently reflected in the January 2025 fixtures against Glenwood, where College secured victories in all 12 matches, including a 119-23 result for the 1st team. As the Red, Black and White prepare for this weekend's fixtures, the programme continues to emphasize depth, pride, and a high standard of play across every age group and team level.



CRICKET AT MARITZBURG COLLEGE

Maritzburg College, founded in 1863, has sustained a cricketing tradition that stretches back more than 150 years, with the sport becoming deeply embedded in the school's culture and ethos from its early development. Over time, cricket grew alongside the school's expanding sporting programme, eventually forming part of a robust system that now includes 22 cricket teams, reflecting the long-established and continuous role the game has played in College life. The historic Goldstone's cricket oval has long been the heart of this tradition, where generations of boys have developed not only their skills but also a profound love for the game, contributing to the production of numerous provincial and international representatives across the decades.

This cricketing legacy has been further strengthened by the school's extensive, top-level facilities and highly trained coaching staff, which provide players with a strong foundation and ample opportunities to grow their game. These resources, combined with regular fixtures against rival schools, support both competitive development and social growth, fostering resilience, teamwork, and a lifelong connection to the sport. The strength of this environment is reflected in the success of notable Old Collegians who went on to represent their countries internationally, including Jonty Rhodes, Kevin Pietersen, and David Miller, reinforcing Maritzburg College's position as a significant contributor to cricket on the world stage.

Water polo at Maritzburg College has developed into one of the school's leading summer sports, forming part of the broader aquatic programme alongside swimming.

The programme enjoyed significant success in the early 2000s, with the 1st team rising to become one of the top schoolboy sides in South Africa, achieving national prominence in both 2001 and 2002. This period helped establish a strong foundation for the sport at College and inspired future generations of players.

In the modern era, water polo at College continues to grow in strength and depth, with multiple teams competing across all age groups and regular participation in the country's leading school tournaments. The programme remains highly competitive within KwaZulu-Natal and nationally, supported by quality coaching, strong player development, and excellent aquatic facilities.

Water polo continues to play an important role in the sporting life of the school, promoting teamwork, resilience, and the proud sporting traditions of Maritzburg College.



